



USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

LOCAL RULES

A player has an extra option to take relief (per rule 16.1b) when immovable obstructions (such as a sprinkler head, drain, etc.) are close to the putting green and on the line of play, when both the ball and the obstruction are in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less (MLR F-5.2). This is allowed if the obstruction is:

- On the player's line of play
- Within two club lengths of the putting green, and
- Within two club lengths of the ball

Penalty Area (PA) Edges - Stakes identify the location of a PA, however the PA edge is defined as the natural grass border. The stakes have no other meaning and are moveable obstructions.

COURSE RULES

Protection of Putting Greens - A player must not make a stroke from any putting green with any club other than a putter. Free relief is allowed by locating the nearest point of complete relief (for Lie Only) and drop within one club length, no nearer the hole. After the drop procedure is completed, any club may be used.

Reclaimed Water - To help conserve drinking water, a portion of the irrigation water used on the Desert Mountain Club's courses and lakes is reclaimed. PLEASE DO NOT DRINK.
